

Fly-tippers beware as SHDC are increasing Fixed Penalty Notices (FPNs) to better tackle and be a further deterrent to enviro-crime cases such as fly-tipping, littering, graffiti and fly-posting. The FPN's are used by SHDC as an alternative to prosecutions through the courts system, and are a quick and efficient way for the offender to admit liability and pay a financial penalty. Since the implementation



of enviro-crime earlier this year, there has been a significant increase of FPN's being issued and these increases should further makes potential offenders think again before committing a crime.

A review of the area's bin collections in order to improve 'efficiency and resilience' of service is taking place very soon, with residents shortly receiving a letter from SHDC to confirm their green and black bag collection dates, after the assessment has been completed. The letter will confirm the date of implementation and will be based from looking at round changes to improve both efficiency and resilience of the waste and recycling collection service. Please look out for this important information.

Congratulations to two organisations in our Ward who were successful as part of almost £1.3m awarded across the South and East Lincolnshire Partnership to help boost small community groups and projects thanks to a new grants scheme. Funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, the scheme aims to meet an already high demand from parishes and strengthen the social fabric of communities. This could be through building pride in place by improving community facilities, creating opportunities to bring people together or creating social connections that will grow and thrive. Here is a breakdown for the projects and groups which have been successful from the most recent round in securing a grant:

Weston Parish Council – Weston Hills Park - £24,999, Gosberton Snooker and Bowls Club - £4,250, Donington – Flinders Park Improvement Project - £24,000, Cowbit Village Hall - £20,040, Fleet Parish Council – Playing Field Development - £9,311.

If this is of interest to your community group, applications are still open and there is still time to apply for the next round of funding, with grants of up to £24,999 available to help places invest in or restore their community spaces, such as improvements to village halls, events which bring communities together, community play areas, local transport initiatives and projects aimed at reducing the cost of living or improving digital connectivity. Spicy pumpkin soup

Method

South Holland Voluntary Car Service

South Holland Parish Voluntary Car Service is a charity supported by many of the parishes in South Holland. The objective of the scheme is to provide low cost subsidised transport to people in need via the use of private cars driven by volunteers who have been vetted by Lincolnshire County Council.

There are currently 58 volunteer drivers in the district who provide friendly and reliable door to door travel for all ages and disabilities within the community. There are no waiting charges for those using the service, an option for both male and female drivers, flexible service for all appointments for hospitals, medical centres, dentists, chiropodist and shopping (if drivers are available). The minimum journey cost is £4.

Drivers receive 45p per mile which comprises 35p collected from the passenger and 10p from the charity funds. The scheme is always needing <u>more drivers</u> and would encourage anyone with some spare time on their hands to consider becoming a volunteer. 



HOPEFULLY MANY OF YOU ARE NOW AWARE THAT THE BUS SHELTERS PROMISED ARE NOW IN SITU ALONG THE HIGH RD IN WESTON, ALTHOUGH MANY COMMENTS ON FACEBOOK WERE COMPLIMENTARY, SOME COMPLAINED THAT THERE WERE NO SIDES TO THE SHELTERS WHICH ARE THE CANTILEVER STYLE AND THE REASON WE COULD NOT HAVE

ENCLOSED SHELTERS IS WE CANNOT OBSTRUCT THE PAVEMENT AREA IN MOST LOCATIONS.

THE COUNCIL ARE NOW IN THE STAGES OF ARRANGING PHASED INSTALLATION OF NEW PLAY EQUIPMENT IN WESTON PARK AND THIS WILL INCLUDE A ZIP WIRE, A STREET 73 PLAY EQUIPMENT AND A BASKETBALL HOOP. IT IS OUR INTENTION TO INSTALL EQUIPMENT IN PHASED TIME FRAME SO HOPEFULLY THE FIRST PHASE SHOULD START IN LATE SEPTEMBER EARLY OCTOBER WITH FURTHER PHASES BEGINNING IN THE SPRING. ALSO IN LINE FOR UPDATING ARE THE GATES TO THE PARK WHICH WILL BE FULLY AUTOMATIC ON TIMED PHASES THROUGH THE DAY 24/7.

WE HAVE JUST HEARD AND WITH THANKS TO CLLR JANET BELLAMY, WESTON PARISH COUNCIL WILL RECEIVE A FURTHER £25,000 SOLELY FOR WESTON HILLS PARK THROUGH SHDC COMMUNITY PROSPERITY FUND. THIS MONEY WILL BE USED TO FURTHER UPDATE PARK EQUIPMENT FOR ALL.

ON A DOWN NOTE, THERE HAVE BEEN INSTANCES OF DAMAGE TO TREES AND PLAY EQUIPMENT WITHIN WESTON PARK AND IN FAIRNESS CAN ONLY BE ATTRIBUTED TO CHILDREN ATTENDING THE PARK DURING THE SCHOOL HOLIDAYS AND I HAVE TO SAY WHAT CAN WE EXPECT ONCE THE NEW EQUIPMENT IS INSTALLED.

I CAN ONLY ASK PARENTS TO INSTILL IN THEIR CHILDREN THE IMPORTANCE OF LEAVING TREES ETC ALONE OTHERWISE THE QUESTION WILL BE ASKED AS TO WHY SHOULD WE SPEND THOUSANDS OF POUNDS ON NEW AND IMPROVED PLAY EQUIPMENT IF ITS ONLY TO BE DAMAGED BY THOSE ATTENDING THE PARK, BEARING IN MIND IT IS RESIDENTS AND THEIR CHILDREN WHO HAVE REQUESTED THE PARISH COUNCIL TO UPGRADE EQUIPMENT FOR THEIR ENJOYMENT.




