

Christmas came early as it was announced that SHDC owned Moulton Park is to be sold, with the vast majority being purchased by the John Biggadike Foundation. Andrew, Anthony and Thomas are delighted with this announcement, which will lead to the park finally being open to the general public. At the time of writing this article, a planning application for "Change of use from agricultural



parkland to parkland for recreational use by the community" submitted by the John and Maureen Biggadike Foundation is under consultation. This will hopefully compliment another application submitted by the Moulton's Parish Council for similar change of use within Moulton Park, which was approved in January. We would like to put on record our sincere thanks to Cllr Henry Bingham who moved this forward at pace since becoming SHDC Portfolio Holder for Assets and Strategic Planning in May 2023. As ultimate decision maker, if it were not for Henry, the park gates may have remained frustratingly closed. We now keep our fingers and toes crossed the sale and planning applications go through smoothly and the public will be able to enjoy access in the park sometime in 2024.

We were saddened to hear of the sad passing of Prof Benjamin Zephaniah, who died in early December. A resident in Moulton Chapel for a number of years, Benjamin was just "one of the villagers" and very often seen around Moulton Chapel and the wider area. A nationally, and even globally recognised poet, campaigner and actor, Benjamin will be greatly missed and may he rest in peace.

The South and East Lincolnshire Community Lottery has raised £34.7k during its first year, supporting local community groups and charities such as Moulton Windmill. With over 590 residents across the local authority partnership of South Holland, Boston and East Lindsey playing every week, a typical week for the community lottery scheme can see more than £600 raised for good causes. 60% of the ticket proceeds from South & East Lincolnshire Community Lottery go to charities, voluntary organisations and other not-for-profit groups with the remainder being put towards prizes, operating costs and VAT.



















The Doctor of Hiroshima is the extraordinary true story of Dr Michihiko Hachiya, whose hospital was less than a mile from the centre of the atomic bomb that hit on that warm August day. In immense shock and pain, he and his wife Yaeko dragged themselves to the devastated hospital building and what colleagues they could find. Valentine Cookies



- Preheat the oven to 200°C, 400°F (gas mark 6).
- 2. Lightly grease 2 large baking trays or line with baking paper.
- 3. Mix the two types of flour and salt thoroughly in a large mixing bowl.
- 4. Melt the butter until no solid bits remain.
- 5. Tip the soft brown sugar, caster sugar and vanilla essence into the melted butter and combine everything thoroughly an electric hand whisk is helpful here.
- Break the eggs into a cup and when you are sure that the melted butter mixture is cool enough not to scramble the eggs, beat the eggs into the mixture.
- Next tip the butter mixture into the flour mixture and mix well.
- 8. Add in the crushed Smarties or M&M's and mix again until everything is fully combined.
- Divide the dough into about 12 pieces then roll each piece into a ball and place onto the 2 baking trays, making sure they are evenly spaced. Flatten each ball with the palm of your hand.
- 10. Add the decorations to the tops of the flattened dough and then bake in the oven for 10 minutes. You want the cookies to still feel very soft in the centre.
- Transfer the cookies to a cooling rack as soon as they are out of the oven and enjoy once cooled.



Ingredients

- 200 gms plain flour
- 200 gms self raising flour
- ½ tsp salt
- 170 gms softened butter
- 200 gms soft brown sugar
- 100 gms caster sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla essence
- 1 egg plus 1 egg yolk
- 100 gms pink and red Smarties or M&M's – lightly crushed
- Decorations pink sprinkles, more pink and red Smarties or M&M's, cream or brandy butter!



What's Involved?

Parish Councillors normally attend twelve council meetings a year. Meetings are normally held on the first Monday of the month and alternate between Weston and Weston Hills Village halls. The meetings normally take between one and three hours. Occasionally extra meetings can be called to discuss specific matters.

Recently the Parish Council installed six new Bus shelters on the High Road Weston and now it's about to install more play equipment in Weston Hills and upgrade Weston playing field with new play equipment, CCTV cameras, electric gates and much more. You could contribute to making these decisions

Eligibility to be a Councillor.

The Parish Council is able to consider any person to fill the vacancy provided that: The person is 18 or over: and

The person is a British Citizen, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any other member state of the European Union.

And at least one of the following apply:

The person is an elector for the Parish and continues to be an elector; or

The Person has resided in the Parish for the past twelve months or rented/tenanted land in the Parish; or The Person has had their principal or only place of work in the Parish for the past twelve months; or

The person has lived within three miles of the Parish for the past twelve months.




